
## Checklist for preparation to transition to iQIES

- Be prepared to document your measures in iQIES

## iQIES Log In

## **HARP-** Creating an Account through HCQIS Access Roles and Profile

- What is: (HARP) is a secure identity management portal provided by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Creating an account via HARP provides users with a user ID and password that can be used to sign into many CMS applications. It also provides a single location for users to modify their user profile, change their password, update their challenge question, and add and remove two-factor authentication devices.
- **What is HCQIS?**  
Healthcare Quality Information System (HCQIS) is the CMS system responsible for various quality reporting applications.

HARP supports only login for the following CCSQ applications.

- Deliverable Administration Review Repository Tool (DARRT)
- ESRD Quality Reporting System (EQRS)
- Hospital Quality Reporting (HQR)
- Internet Quality Improvement Evaluation System (iQIES)
- Quality Management and Review System (QMARS)
- Quality Payment Program (QPP)
- Quality Safety & Education Portal (QSEP)

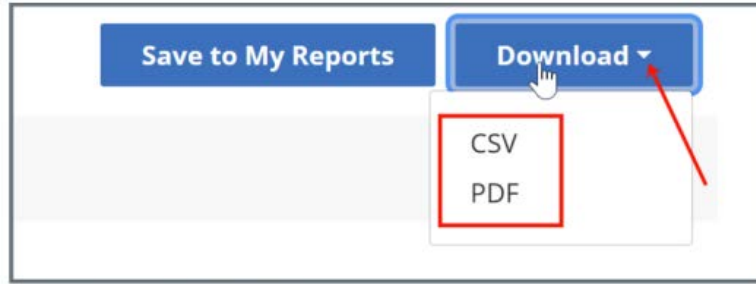
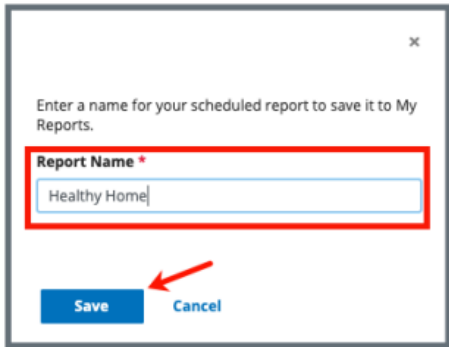


Figure 17: Download a Report

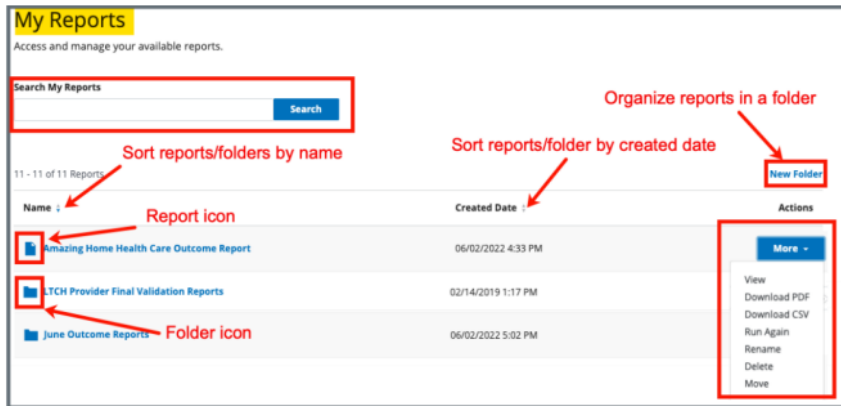


Figure 19: My Reports

2.8.1 Click **My Reports** on the top menu **Reports** tab to find specific reports that have been saved. See *Figure 19, My Reports*.

Report Name	Report Category	Report Type	Report Purpose
<b>MDS 3.0 Facility-Level Quality Measure (QM) Report</b>	Quality Measure	Facility-Level Quality Measure	Displays the facility percentage and how the facility compares with other facilities in their state and in the nation for each quality measure. This report helps facilities identify possible areas for further emphasis in facility quality improvement activities or investigation during the survey process.
<b>MDS 3.0 Resident-Level Quality Measure (QM) Report</b>	Quality Measure	Resident/Patient-Level Quality Measure	Displays the residents (active and discharged) who were included in the calculations for the selected facility and period that were used to produce the MDS 3.0 Facility-Level Quality Measure (QM) Report. The report lists the residents by name and indicates the measures, if any, triggered by each.
